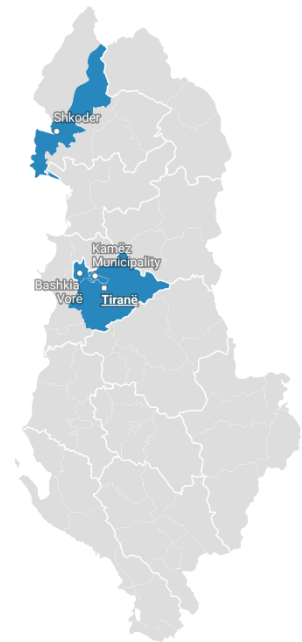

Project Title: Breaking Barriers: Empowering Deaf Youth for Inclusive Employment in Albania

Overall objective is to promote social and economic inclusion for deaf youth in Albania by enhancing their access to employment opportunities and active labor market programs, thereby fostering their independence, reducing unemployment, and supporting their full participation in society.

In collaboration with NAES and targeted municipalities the project will enhance employment opportunities for 100 deaf youth in Shkodra, Tirana, Kamza, and Vora by capacity building, increasing access to employment programs, strengthening collaboration and promoting good practices. It will ensure at least 10% secure job placements, internships, or vocational training. Social workers in each municipality will receive specialized training to better support deaf job seekers, and informational materials in Albanian sign language will be developed to ensure accessibility.
