Project Title: Foundations for success: Empowering adult learners through essential skills

The overall objective is to provide an integrated training program for vulnerable groups in Tirana and Shkodra, focusing on improving basic literacy, numeracy, and digital skills, alongside psycho-social support, and career mentoring to ensure smoother transitions into part-time basic education, vocational training and employment.

The project aims to empower 200 vulnerable individuals in Tirana and Shkodra by providing psycho-social support, career guidance, and essential skills training in literacy, numeracy, and digital competencies. Through a blended learning approach, it will ensure a comprehensive and adaptive educational experience. The program will also support a group of beneficiaries in enrolling in part-time education, helping them transition to further training or employment. A sustainability plan, including a framework for institutionalizing the program and support services will be developed and will foster long-term collaboration between NAES, municipalities, and educational institutions.
